ORDINANCE NO. 1137

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NON-BUDGETED FUND, PURSUANT TO KSA 79-2925(a)(2) TO HOLD DONATED FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A LIBRARY ANNEX

WHEREAS, The City has received requests from interested citizens and the Haysville Community Library to consider the construction of a library annex to serve certain functions of the library including housing a Haysville Historical Museum, additional meeting rooms and other purposes (“Annex”);

WHEREAS, Community Members have also requested that the City open a Non-Budgeted Special Fund to house donations towards the construction of the Annex (“Library Annex Fund”); and

WHEREAS, The Governing Body of the City of Haysville, Kansas finds that the establishment of the Library Annex Fund is in the best interest of the City of Haysville and an appropriate place to house donations towards the construction of the Annex and that such account is appropriate under KSA 79-2925(a)(2).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAYSVILLE, KANSAS:

Section 1. Establishment. That a special fund is hereby established pursuant to KSA 79-2925(a)(2) for the construction of the Annex to the Haysville Community Library (Library Annex Fund”).

Section 2. Funds Held. The Library Annex Fund shall only hold money received as a gift or bequest.

Section 3. Use of Funds. The funds contained in the Library Annex Fund shall only be used for planning, including site engineering and architectural design, and construction of the Annex and for no other purposes.


Section 4. Termination. Any funds remaining in the Library Annex Fund after the completion of the Annex shall be used to pay for maintenance items at the Annex until depleted.

Section 5. Severability. Should any section, clause, sentence or phrase of this ordinance be found to be unconstitutional or is otherwise held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any remaining provision herein.
